```

To get additional usage help on starting mini-project-2 run the following console command:

```
mini-project-2 --help
```

Command Line Use

Start the mini-project-2 shell

```
usage: mini_project_2 [-h] [--log-level LOG_LEVEL] [--log-dir LOG_DIR] [-v]
```
